Contestants will be judged on originality, content and the ability to portray a positive image of hunting and the shooting sports we all enjoy.

**PRIZES:**

There will be one winner and one alternate in each age category. Winners will receive a new shotgun and an expense paid trip to Russell County to hunt wild birds on an 1800 acre ranch during the youth pheasant season in 2010.

Alternates will win a premium hunting accessory package.
